WHEREAS, the Jackson Township Trustees have a responsibility to oversee the general health and welfare of the citizens of Jackson Township; and


WHEREAS, a large dairy facility proposed to be constructed on Cygnet Road, just 3 miles from the Village of Hoytville, can place a tremendous demand on the water supply and pose numerous environmental hazards to the surrounding area; and


WHEREAS, the citizens of Jackson Township have expressed serious concerns about the negative impact the dairy operation will have on the quality of life in and near Southern Wood County including odor, pollution of groundwater, pollution of waterways, excess consumption of water, and the negative impact on property values,


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the proposed mega-dairy is not in the best interests of the residents of Jackson Township. It is also resolved that the potential for water pollution, air pollution, traffic congestion, road damage, increased expenses, and loss of tax base is not acceptable.
