

RESOLUTION NO. 2-2006

A RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS TO ESTABLISH CONFINED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATIONS WITHIN SANDUSKY COUNTY, OHIO, AND IN SUPPORT OF A PROPOSED MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS WITHIN THE STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, two Confined Animal Feeding Operations, each with more than 2,000 cows, are planned to be constructed in Scott and Woodville townships; and

WHEREAS, information has been received and reviewed by local government officials which suggest several quality of life issues may exist surrounding the maintenance and operation of Confined Animal Feeding Operations; and

WHEREAS, local government officials, and the residents of the Village of Gibsonburg require time to investigate and study the possible erosion of air and water quality within the Village of Gibsonburg, if a Confined Animal Feeding Operation were established.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Village of Gibsonburg:


SECTION 1 – That the Village of Gibsonburg hereby urges the Department of Agriculture to withhold issuance of permits to establish Confined Animal Feeding Operations within Sandusky County, Ohio until all safety, air, and ground water quality issues have been fully addressed to the satisfaction of local government officials, thus allowing us to reassure residents they will continue to enjoy clean air and water.



SECTION 4 – That this publication shall be by posting at five public locations.


